Mist-Birkenfeld RFPD provides fire, emergency medical, ambulance, and rescue services to 1,388 residents living within our District, plus countless seasonal visitors. The District's office staff supports 51 volunteers, who respond out of four stations, providing services in 165 square miles of Columbia and Clatsop counties.

THE SEASONAL FIREFIGHTER POSITION

Firefighter is an hourly position and provides emergency assistance and protective services to citizens. They work under guidelines provided by the Fire Chief to respond to emergency calls, provide fire suppression, rescue, and emergency medical services, and fire prevention duties as assigned. Other responsibilities include maintenance of fire stations, equipment, and apparatus, participating in drills and training activities, and actively involved in public relation events as scheduled, and other duties and assignments associated with the goals and mission of the Fire District.

Acceptable Experience and Training:

- High school diploma or GED equivalency
- Must possess and maintain a valid driver's license and a safe driving record
- Any combination of experience and training which provides the equivalent scope of knowledge, skill, and abilities necessary to perform the work

Required Special Qualifications

- Possess certifications in ICS 100, 200, and IS 700 and 800.
- NFPA 472 Operations Level Responder
- NFPA Firefighter I or equivalent
- Wildland Firefighter type 2

HIRING PROCESS

- Application open until filled
- Interviews will be scheduled upon receiving applications
- Chief's interview: Last week of June
- Anticipated start date: July 5, 2022

Applications will be accepted in person, electronically via email, or sent through the US Postal Service; **faxed applications will be rejected without notification.**

A completed application packet should include only the following documents:

- Signed Application
- Application Acknowledgment Form
- Veteran's Preference Form and DD-214/DD-215 if applicable (Veterans Only)
- Documents showing you meet the minimum requirements of position
